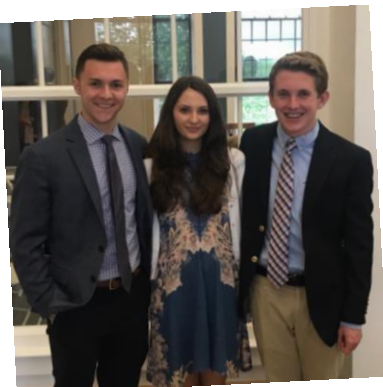
ALUMNI UPDATES
