



Academy Hill Scholars Supply List 2018-2019

Scholars - Grades 6, 7 & 8

- (1) Trapper-type binder with **six** 2-pocket folders (Required for Grade 6; suggested for Grades 7 & 8)
- Loose leaf notebook paper (a year's supply)
 - 3-hole puncher (flat for trapper) for French students
- Graph paper for three ring binders; preferably two-sided
(30 sheets should suffice; regular lined paper should be used for math work unless grid or graph paper is necessary.)
- Inexpensive earbuds or headphones (labeled with student's name) to keep at school
- #2 pencils & erasers; mechanical pencils are encouraged (to be replenished as needed); manual pencil sharpener for French students
6, 7 & 8: PLEASE NOTE THAT ALL ERASERS MUST BE LATEX FREE
- Blue or black pens
- Binders (1") for Math, Literacy, Social Studies, Science, Latin, and French/Spanish; student's name should be printed on spine
- 5 sets of 6 binder dividers with labels (for subject binders)
- (15) Clear plastic 3-ring sheet protectors
- 3-subject Five-Star brand notebook - 1 required for grade 6, and 2 required for grades 7 & 8 - (5-Star brand notebooks hold up the best over the year)
- Colored pencils (at least 12) (erasable may be helpful)
- 1 set of Highlighters: pink, blue, yellow, green and orange (for all grades)
- Pouch to hold pens and pencils
- At least 3 packs of 3x5 lined index cards (to be replenished as needed)
- Ruler with both U.S. system and metric system
- Protractor (**all grades**)
- Basic (simple) calculator; (TI calculator for Grade 8 Algebra II students)
- 4 stretch-type textbook covers
- A **working printer and paper** that student has access to at home **throughout the year**
- Box of tissues

For Forum:

- Package of 5x8 index cards and metal ring (**all** grades)
- Loose Leaf Rings

Optional:

- Mouse for ChromeBook use, if preferred. (Do not plan to borrow the school's.)
